Pursuant l'art. 80 paragraph 4 of the "University Regulations for Administration, Finance and Accounting" and the "Regulation of scholarships for the conduct of research activities," **a selection on the basis of qualifications** is announced for no. 1 scholarship for the conduct of research activities, to be carried out at the Department of Historical, Geographical Sciences and the Ancient World under the scientific responsibility of **Dr. Sergi Sancho Fibla**.

The fellowship will have a duration of **9 months**.

The **total amount of €14,500.00** will be funded by the Department of Historical and Geographic Sciences and the Ancient World with funds from the STARS@UNIPD 2021 grant (MAGISTRAE project) awarded to Dr. Sergi Sancho Fibla.

**The research to be conducted by the fellow aims to:**

The researcher is to carry out archival work to examine documents related to the first girls schools established in Iberia in the late Middle Ages, as well as information on the women who carried out the educational initiatives. This involves studying several archival funds in Spain. Subsequently, this information will have to be inventoried in the project database. At the end of the research activity the fellow will have to deliver a report on his/her work and will be invited to participate in a collective book that will be published later.

Knowledge of the Baserow computer software  
Knowledge of the religious history of Castile in the late Middle Ages  
Knowledge of and experience in late medieval paleography

Scientific publications  
Documented relevant scholarly and research activities

**Incompatibility**

The research grant cannot be combined with:

- grants for research activities;
- scholarships conferred for any reason, except those granted by national and foreign research institutions for the purpose of integrating, with stays abroad, the specific activity envisaged by the work program carried out by the holder;

In the case of self-employed or subordinate or parasubordinate employment relationships, compatibility will be attested by the Scientific Director.

Research grants may not be awarded to those who have a spousal relationship or a degree of kinship or affinity, up to and including the fourth degree, with teaching staff or tenured researchers belonging to the structure proposing the selection or with the Rector, Director General or members of the Board of Directors of the University.

**Modalities for submitting the application for participation**

The application to participate in the selection must be submitted within the peremptory deadline of 15 days starting from the day following the date of publication of this notice on the University's official notice board.

The application must be accompanied by:

- (c) any other document, title or publication, useful for the selection.

### **Selection Procedures**

Applications will be evaluated by an Examining Board, appointed in accordance with the provisions of the "Regulations of Fellowships for the Performance of Research Activities," on the basis of qualifications.

The Examining Board, before proceeding to the evaluation of the candidates, will determine the maximum score to be awarded, the criteria and the manner of evaluation of the qualifications.

At the end of its work, the Board will forward the minutes of the competitive operations to the Head of the Department of Historical and Geographic Sciences and the Ancient World for the fulfillment of its duties.

The Head of the Department of Historical and Geographic Sciences and the Ancient World, having verified the legitimacy of the acts, will proceed by his own decree to approve them and award the grant.

The secretariat of the Department of Historical and Geographic Sciences and the Ancient World will transmit the awarding measure to the successful person.

Within ten days of receipt of the award decision, the successful person must, under penalty of forfeiture, accept the fellowship. In case of forfeiture, the scholarship will be awarded following the order of the final merit list.

### **Withdrawal of documents and publications**

Retrieval of documents and publications sent to this University may be arranged at one's own expense, two months after the completion of the selection process, subject to any pending litigation.

The personal data transmitted with the applications to participate in the selection procedure, in accordance with Legislative Decree no. 196 of June 30, 2003, as amended and supplemented, will be processed exclusively for the purposes of managing this procedure and the possible subsequent assignment of the grant.
