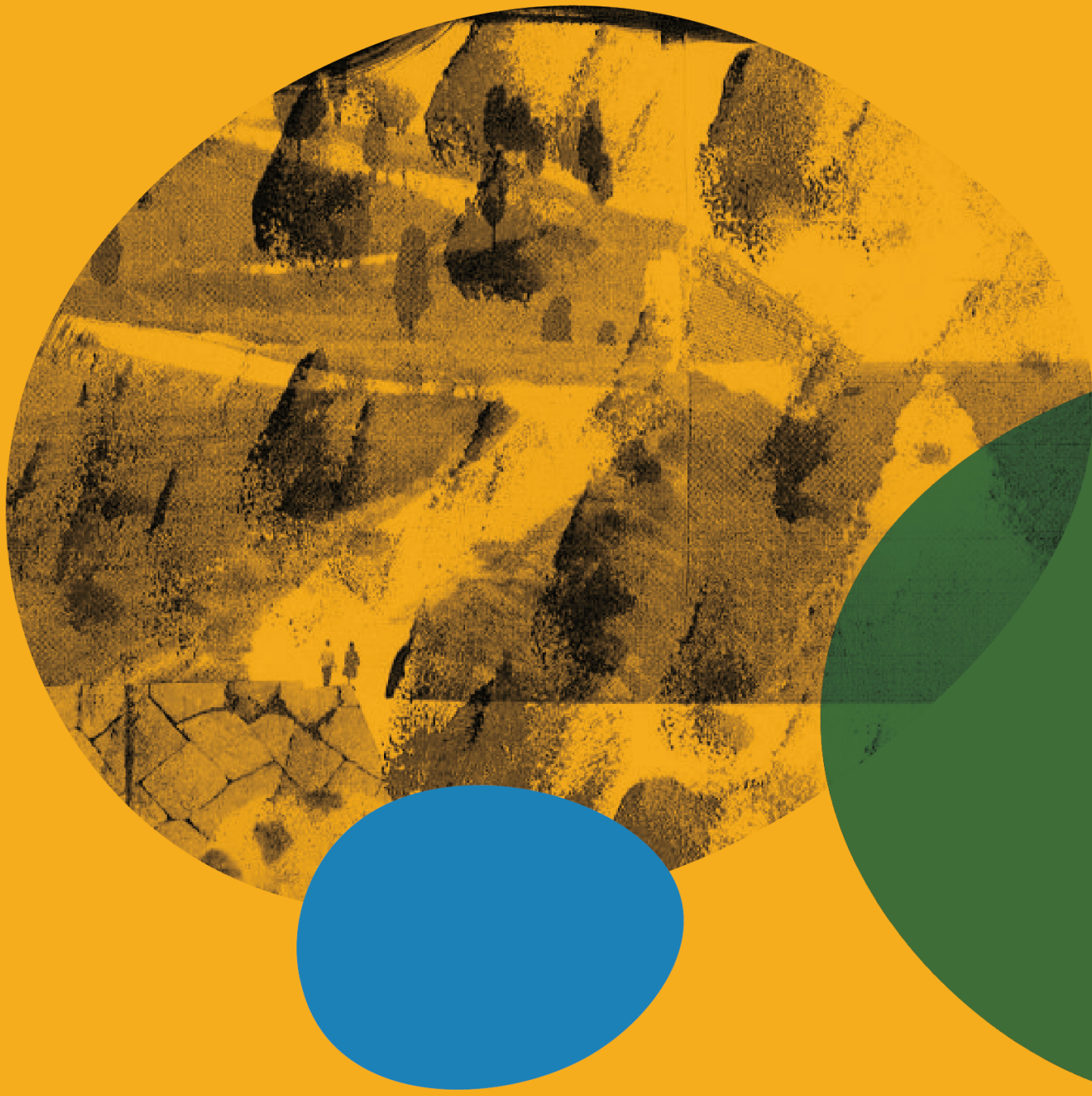




Inside Transformative Methods

Crafting Geographies of multi(species/spatial) Crises

Inside Transformative Methods are days for dialogue and exchange on transformative geographical methods, understood as situated practices that intertwine theoretical reflection and grounded experience to enact collective change. These days are a shared space to critically reflect on how, where, and with whom transformative knowledge is produced amid the polycrises of the present. This reflection pushes us to imagine tools capable of questioning and challenging structures of precarity and injustice at a time of violence and rapid, disorienting shifts. Bridging voices from research, arts, activism, and cultural organisations, we engage with theoretical inputs, dialogues, and workshops that tackle both potentials and limitations of imagining, practising, and understanding change through geographical lenses and methods.

We propose to craft new geographies together: imagining and producing tools, weaving alliances, walking knowledge out of academia and into the street. Each day explores a different dimension of this *geographical crafting*. The first turns to collective change itself, activating the streets as public/contested/plural spaces through geographical theories and practices. The street here is both a metaphor of a place of sharing and convergence, and a field of change, contestation, and reappropriation. The second turns to geographical objects - artefacts, embroidered and edited materials that make and activate knowledge by hand. A *multisp(ecies/atial)* perspective holds these dimensions together: to the multiple scales across which transformation moves (from an object, a neighbourhood, a geopolitical chessboard), and to the human and more-than-human actors who inhabit and remake these spaces of crisis.
